Section 20-5-109, MCA Nonpublic school requirements for compulsory enrollment exemption To qualify its students for exemption form compulsory enrollment under Section 20-5-102, MCA, a non public or home school shall:

- (1) Maintain records on pupil attendance and disease immunization and make the records available to the county superintendent of schools on request;
- (2) Provide at least 180 days of pupil instruction or the equivalent in accordance with 20-1-301 and 20-1-302;
- (3) Be housed in a building that complies with applicable local health and safety regulations;
- (4) Provide an organized course of study that includes instruction in the subjects required of public schools as a basic instructional program pursuant to 20-7-111.
