Scope/Purpose of Project: This project's main purpose is to remove silt and sediment which has been deposited through the years within the dam. Silt & sediment has begun to build up in front of the Dam Outfall Structure. Wetlands are located upstream of the dam. The materials shall be removed via scraper, excavator, and dozer. The materials will be hauled and stockpiled at an upland location away from the floodplain. Currently the banks are well vegetated and have slope protection upstream of the dam. The existing channel is well defined with no vegetation in the streambed. The stream banks and floodplains are vegetated both upstream and downstream of the dam. The dam bottom has no vegetation. The slope of the banks varies from 2:1 to 3:1 downstream and 4:1 upstream of the dam. The project will temporarily impact 50 feet of bank where equipment will ingress and egress from the dam bottom. Approximately 25 acres of the dam bottom will be temporarily impacted during dredging. The vegetation that will be disturbed for the entire project is approximately 3 acres at the stockpile location. 70,000 cubic yards of dredged material is proposed to be removed from the Upper Baker Reservoir.
