



## Fallon County Weed Board

### Minutes

The August meeting of the Fallon County Weed Board was called to order by Chairman Bruha at 7:15 on the night of the 8<sup>th</sup>. Those members present were as follows: Bruha, Malcom, Gonsioroski, Buerkle and Wolenetz. Board secretary Butori took minutes.

Prior to the meeting the board was given time to review the minutes and budget from the previous month. Seeing no additions or corrections the minutes and budget were approved as presented.

The board allowed time for public comment. Seeing none the board moved forward with regular business.

Buerkle commented on a bill he had seen in the budget report for a new radiator. Butori explained that the crew had run a stick the radiator on one of the Gators. He had it replaced and the old one would be repaired and shelved as a spare. Conversation was held on places Butori could have the radiator repaired.

Butori reported that the county's insurance adjuster had been in town looking at the damage from the hail storm in July. He went on to explain to the board that the shop had taken damage to all windows, several doors, the roof and two walls. Repairs would be made but Butori had no idea when.

Butori told the board that the Montana Department of labor had been through and inspected all the county shops including the weed department. He was happy to announce that the building passed all the inspections.

Butori gave an update on the season to date. He reported the crew had done a really good job this summer and would start leaving soon. All landowners on the list had been sprayed for and Butori was going to start fall spurge spraying soon.

Conversation was held on the listing of Common Mullin as a county listed noxious weed. Butori presented the board with information about the plant. After conversation was held on both sides the board decided not to list Common Mullin as a noxious weed at this time.

Butori reported that he was still working on the Fall Coordinator Training that was being held in Baker this year. He explained that the board may be asked to make an appearance at this meeting in October.

Seeing no other business the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the Fallon County Weed Board will be held on the night of September 12<sup>th</sup>.
