The May 2019 meeting of the Fallon County Weed Board was called to order on the night of the 14<sup>th</sup> at 7:00PM. Those members present were as follows; Bruha, Gonsioroski, and Wyrick. Board Secretary Butori took minutes.

The board was given time prior to the meeting to review the minutes and budget from the last month. Seeing no additions or corrections to the minutes and budget report, they were approved as presented. The board allowed time for public comment. Seeing none the board moved on to regular business.

Butori presented the chemical bids for 2019. Conversation had been held on accepting all bids this season to make it easier for Butori to get chemical as needed and to try and save the county some money. Gonsioroski made a motion to accept all chemical bids presented for the 2019-2020 spray season. Wyrick seconded the motion. The motion passed. The board took time to set the chemical prices as follows.

Chemical	Price per unit
Picloram	\$42.00 / Gallon
2,4-D	\$10.00 / Gallon
Milestone	\$71.00 / Quart
Liberate	\$20.00 / Gallon
Blue Dye	\$39.00 / Jug

Conversation was held on a discussion held at the previous meeting. It had been decided that no chemical would be sold and no work would be done for a landowner that did not have a management plan approved. Butori explained that this was going to place undue burden on the staff in the Extension Office. He asked that the board consider allowing the purchase of chemical, but withhold cost-share from a landowner until a plan is approved. Wyrick made a motion to allow for the sale of chemical without an approved plan and withhold cost-share until the plan is on file with the Weed Department. Gonsioroski seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Butori presented the board with ten management plans for review. Those plans were from. John Medearis, Clayton Wenz, Andrew Paul, Brian Rustad, Alvin & Robert Wenz, Marvin Gookin, Leonard Ehret, Mike Nelson, Walter Hanratty and Dennis Erickson. Wyrick made a motion to approve all the plans as presented. Gonsioroski seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Butori reported on his radio interview he had done with Taylor Brown from the Northern Ag. Network. He explained that it was fun but nothing he needed to do on a regular basis.

Seeing no other business, the meeting was adjourned. The next meeting of the Fallon County Weed Board will be held at 7:00PM on the night of June 10<sup>th</sup>.
