Order of Protection: If you are the victim of partner/family member assault, or the victim of sexual assault or stalking, you have the right to request an Order of Protection (temporary or permanent) for any of the following provisions:

- \*prohibiting the offender from either threatening to hurt you or actually hurting you;
- \*directing the offender to leave your home;
- \*prohibiting the offender from having any contact with you;
- \*prohibiting the offender from transferring any property, except in the usual course of business;
- \*prohibiting the offender from being within 1,500 feet (or other appropriate distance) of you and any named family member, or from being at your worksite or any other specified place;
- \*giving you possession of necessary personal property;
- \*prohibiting the offender from using or possessing any firearm used in the assault.

Obtaining an Order of Protection: You can request an Order through BRAVVor the Victim/Witness Assistance Program. For additional information and assistance call or meet with an advocate. No appointment is necessary, and there is no charge for this

Criminal Charges: If Partner/Family Member Assault is committed, the City or County Attorney can file criminal charges.

According to MCA 45-5-209 a NO CONTACT ORDER may be issued at the time that the defendant is charged with a violation of 45-5-206 (Partner/Family Member Assault) and is effective for 72 hours or until the defendant makes the first appearance in court.
